

## KEEPING SAFE ONLINE AT OUR SCHOOL:

### For my own personal safety:

- ✓ I will only use the Internet with adult permission and supervision.
- ✓ I will only email people that my teacher has approved.
- ✓ The messages I send will be polite and responsible.
- ✓ I will not give my home address or telephone number, or arrange to meet someone.
- ✓ I will not use chat and social networking sites at any time.
- ✓ I will report any unpleasant material or messages sent to me. I understand that this report would be confidential and would help protect other pupils and myself.

### All of the teachers and staff at my school will:

- ✓ Encourage me to tell a teacher/responsible adult immediately if I encounter any material that makes me feel uncomfortable or I recognise as inappropriate.
- ✓ Explain to me what to do if I find inappropriate web material. I must switch off the monitor immediately and report to the Headteacher or my class teacher.
- ✓ Teach me how to evaluate Internet content and to be critically aware of the materials I read and shown me how to validate information before accepting its accuracy.
- ✓ Teach E-safety and remind me of e-safety issues when learning with ICT.
- ✓ Ensure I know what to do if cyber-bullying or another safety incident occurs.

## ESPRESSO

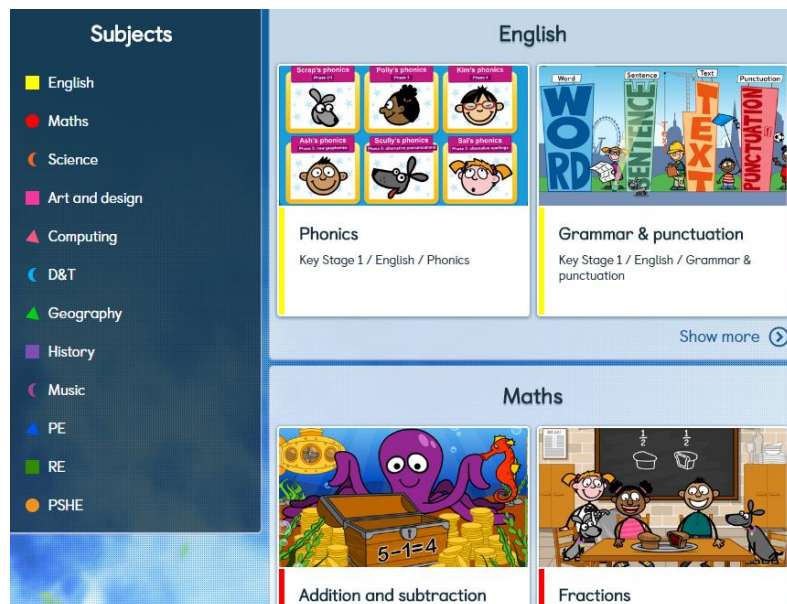
