## How many children met the expected standard in all three subjects?

50% of children in school achieved the expected standard in all three subjects, reading, writing and maths, compared to 65% nationally.

## Progress Measure

This is a measure of the progress children make between the end of Key Stage 1 (Year 2) to the end of Key Stage 2 (Year 6).
